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Hepatitis C (HCV) Prevention Program

The Hepatitis C (HCV) Prevention Program is an extension of the HIV Prevention Program under the Infectious Disease umbrella at the Arkansas Department of Health. The program is federally funded by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and is required to fulfil specific goals and objectives as it relates to HCV prevention. CDC requires the program to:

- Facilitate state and large city viral hepatitis elimination planning.
- Increase access to hepatitis C testing and prevention.
- Increase access to hepatitis C medication assisted treatment (MAT) and treatment services.

The program collaborates with the HCV Surveillance Program to meet these objectives, as well as collaborate with its various community partners and subgrantees. HCV subgrantees are an extension of the program and offer HCV testing and prevention services too.

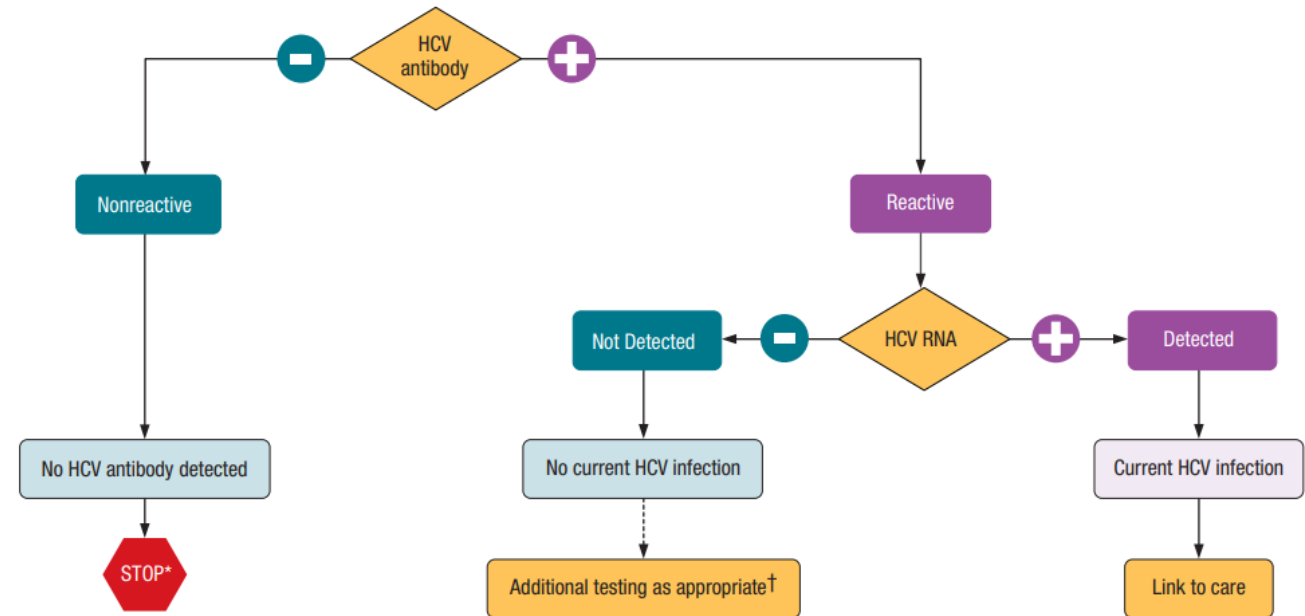
Furthermore, in addition to HCV testing and collaboration, the program offers HCV education and training opportunities. Community members and organizations may attend the HCV training course and become a certified HCV counselor and tester.

* For persons who might have been exposed to HCV within the past 6 months, testing for HCV RNA or follow-up testing for HCV antibody is recommended. For persons who are immunocompromised, testing for HCV RNA can be considered.

† To differentiate past, resolved HCV infection from biologic false positivity for HCV antibody, testing with another HCV antibody assay can be considered. Repeat HCV RNA testing if the person tested is suspected to have had HCV exposure within the past 6 months or has clinical evidence of HCV disease, or if there is concern regarding the handling or storage of the test specimen.

Perinatal Hepatitis C

State of Arkansas House Bill 1136 (Enacted 2021) – An Act To Require Hepatitis C Screening During Pregnancy
[HB1136 as engrossed on 03-17-2021 15:42:35 \(state.ar.us\)](#)

CDC recommends screening pregnant women during each pregnancy, and then testing infants born to mothers with HCV infection. Follow-up of this group to determine if the infant has hepatitis C can be challenging. Testing infants consists of HCV RNA testing at or after age 1-2 months or anti-HCV testing at or after age 18 months.

Active HCV cases are reported to ADH as part of the state's mandatory notifiable disease reporting protocol.

HEPATITIS C COUNSELING AND TESTING CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS (CBO STAFF AND VOLUNTEERS)

Policies:

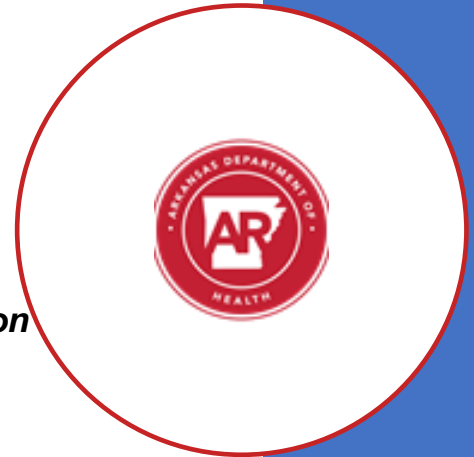
Note: This policy is used by Department of Health employees when training non-ADH personnel.

To become a Certified HCV counselor, a counselor candidate must:

1. Register for the course
2. Attend the HCV Counseling and Testing course in its entirety.

Note: Course participation is a vital component of the HCV training, and any participant who misses any portion of the course in excess of thirty minutes will be withdrawn from the course. If a counselor has special circumstances or a disability, the HIV Prevention program should be notified/made aware.

3. After completion of the course, the participant completes a Post-Course Knowledge Assessment and evaluation.
4. Upon return to their respective organizations, participants use the new counseling techniques and undergo Counseling Reviews by qualified staff members who have successfully gone through the training using the Hepatitis C Counseling and Testing Review Checklist.



HEPATITIS C COUNSELING AND TESTING CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS (CBO STAFF AND VOLUNTEERS)

- Within four months of completing the initial HCV course, counselors must have two counseling reviews completed using the Hepatitis C Counseling and Testing Review Checklist, and at least one peer review must be done prior to the counselor providing any one-on-one counseling and testing to a client without the aid of a certified counselor. The results of the reviews should be discussed between the counselor and the reviewer and shared with the counselor's supervisor. Community Based Organizations (CBO) that are funded by ADH are required to send copies of these reviews to the HIV Program.
- Counseling reviews should be conducted at least once a year. Funded CBOs are required to conduct a review at least once a year for each counselor and send it to the HIV program.
- Volunteers not associated with an organization or program may request someone from the HIV program to serve as a reviewer.
- Agencies not funded by ADH do not have to submit their counseling reviews but should maintain reviews on file at their agency. ADH may request copies if partnering/participating in any events with an agency or organization, and/or if ADH is providing any testing supplies, and/or if a concern arises.
- If further training is needed after completing initial reviews, the counselor's supervisor may extend the review period or request assistance from the HIV program.
- Counselors that do not counsel within the first year of completing the course, must repeat the training session. All counselors must recertify every two years, by completing the online recertification module.

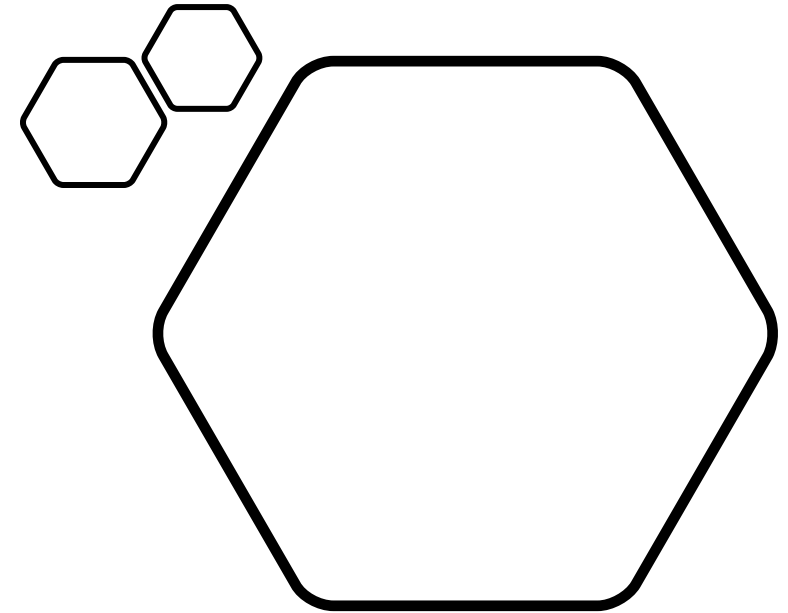
